GATE & PARKING INFORMATION

Everybody (campers and non-campers) who wants to stay past 4:00 PM on ANY of the three days must get a parking pass at the Visitor's Center. It's open till 4 PM and from 5:30--6:30 on Friday, and till 4:00 PM only on Saturday and Sunday.

Please call the Visitor's Center at 233-7323 on the day of your visit if you plan to arrive when they're closed. Know your car's plate number before you call.

The gate is LOCKED at 4PM every day, but it is opened again at these times:

- 🍎 5:30-6:30 PM: Anybody with a parking pass may come and go.
- 🍎 9:00-9:15 PM: Campers and non-campers may EXIT ONLY.

Jam Basics

Never jammed in public? *Now's your chance to jump in!* Here are some tips:

- 🎵 **KEEP IN TUNE**, preferably with an electronic tuner.
- 🎵 **KEEP IN TIME!** Try to synchronize your rhythm with the others jammers.
- 🎵 **BLEND IN!** Please play quietly while others are singing or taking instrumental breaks.
- 🎵 **TAKE TURNS!** The opportunity to suggest a song generally moves around the jam circle.
- 🎵 **BE BOLD!** If you make a mistake in the middle of a song, don't go back to do it over; just go on to the next thing in the song.
- 🎵 **START YOUR OWN JAM!** Many of our regular jammers naturally focus on bluegrass music. Feel free to start a NEW jam, if you'd like to focus on a particular style or pace. Just make sure you're not close to another group of jammers, so the sound doesn't "bleed."
- 🎵 **HAVE FUN!** Remember, that's why we're all here! Please be kind, helpful, considerate and friendly to your fellow pickers and grinners.
